On Sunday, May 19, for the 10:30 AM worship service only, the Chancel Choir of St. Paul's will present a Special Music Sunday

celebrating the choral music of British composer John Rutter. This service will feature two beautiful anthems by Rutter with harp accompaniment – *Amazing Grace* and *Be Thou My Vision*, and John Rutter's ever-popular choral benediction *The Lord Bless You and Keep You*. The centerpiece of this Sunday's musical message will be the presentation of Rutter's *Gloria*. This is a three-movement work supported by brass, organ, and timpani. The three movements of this work take the listener from a feeling of exaltation into a quiet devotional calm, and conclude with unbridled jubilant joy! All this is a perfect backdrop for the Spirit of Pentecost Sunday. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the singers from Trinity Episcopal Ambler will be unable to join us for this presentation as previously announced.

BEAR CREEK CAMP

Bear Creek Summer Camp is a Sunday-through-Friday

overnight program with sessions for children ranging from first-graders to high-school seniors. Campers can experience hiking, swimming, worship, crafts, singing, boating, rope-climbing, games, and more, led by trained staff. Each cabin has modern bath facilities and is convenient to the dining hall. The 3,000-acre camp, located near Wilkes Barre PA just off the Turnpike Northeast Extension and I-81, runs in eight sessions from June 16 through August 9. 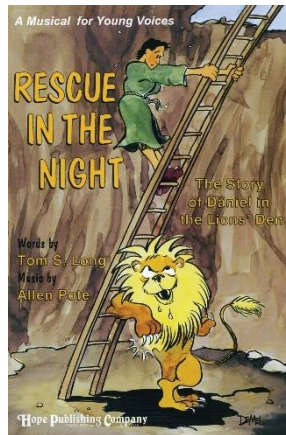
