St. Paul's opens its doors to bring communities together with song!



On Sunday, May 19, for the 10:30 AM worship service only, the Chancel Choir of St. Paul's will join with the singers from Trinity Episcopal, Ambler to present a Special Music Sunday celebrating the choral music of British composer John

Rutter. This service will feature two beautiful anthems by Rutter with harp accompaniment – *Amazing Grace* and *Be Thou My Vision*, and John Rutter's ever-popular choral benediction *The Lord Bless You and Keep You*. The centerpiece of this Sunday's musical message will be the presentation of Rutter's *Gloria*. This is a three-movement work supported by brass, organ, and timpani. The three movements of this work take the listener from a feeling of exaltation into a quite devotional calm, and conclude with unbridled jubilant joy! All this is a perfect backdrop for the Spirit of Pentecost Sunday.
