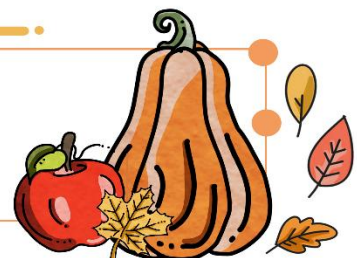
We do have the strudel, but we have a lot of requests for brownies, cupcakes donuts, butter cake, cookies and more. --Thank you, Susan Lech
